TRIP C - 'Urgtal'

The 'Urgtal' is one of the most beautiful high valleys in Tyrol.

Countless streams, lakes and a large number of animals and plants dominate this mountain landscape.

With the exception of traditional mountain agriculture and various hiking trails, this valley is characterized with its myriad of unspoilt creeks, small lakes, wetlands, spring bogs and surrounding spectacular mountain forms.

The cable car will take you to Fisser yoke. The path leads into flat grassy slopes and boulder fields in the 'Urgtal' valley.

Breakfast at 7:30am in the hotel and the first gondola from Fiss at 8:30am.

You will need macro lenses as well as wide angle lenses.

For Bird photographers, you may get the chance of seeing 'Dippers' and 'Grey Wagtails' along the river.



- Breakfast at 7:30am
- First gondola from Fiss at 8:30am
- Hiking Boots required
- Difficult to medium walk
- Equipment: Macro lens & wide angle lens and telephoto lens.
- End of tour: 4pm, transport back to Hotel with "Flotte Berta"
